

Summary:

This course is designed for pharmacy directors, patient safety officers, medication safety officers, nursing directors and other healthcare professionals involved in the development, implementation and administration of the medication management process. We will discuss the components of a safe medication management system including pharmacy workflow, ordering and transcription, preparation, dispensing and administration as wells as data collection, analysis, and use.

Goals and Objectives

By the end of this course, participants will:

- Be familiar with the framework needed for an effective medication management process.
- Be able to develop, implement and provide administrative supervision for a cost effective model of medication management with a focus on patient safety.
- Understand the fundamentals of data collection and use in implementing and maintaining an effective medication management process
